ALL ABOARD TO HUNGARY!!!

The much awaited day has finally come! Two days from now—on August 2nd—we are going to board our flight for Hungary and begin a new, exciting phase in our lives! It is almost too much for us to believe, and the past few months have been an amazing experience for us watching God work.

In our last newsletter, we asked you to pray for the timing of our return to Hungary and for the remaining 30% of our monthly support that we still needed to raise. Well, **God heard your prayers and answered.** By the first part of July, 100% of our monthly support had been pledged, which set in motion a rapid chain of events—we started looking for airline tickets, applied for a long-term

Hungarian visa for John, and began wondering how in the world all our stuff would fit into 4 suitcases!

On top of that, every two years there is a conference for all the UWM missionaries in Europe. And it just so happens that the Euro-conference will be held in Slovenia this year, during the second week of August!

So now, after finding some great airline tickets, the last piece fell dramatically into place last week, when John's Hungarian visa finally arrived in the mail! Which means that not only will we be able to travel with plenty of time before Zsófi's due-date, but we will also be back in Europe in time to attend the Euro-conference!

WHAT'S ON THE HORIZON

What will you be doing in Hungary? *Helping churches to plant new churches, so that every Hungarian will have a chance to hear the good news and to see it lived out in a community of committed Christians.*

Where are you going to live? *In Budapest, the capitol city of Hungary.*

What will John be doing? *For the first year, John will continue to deepen his language skills, as well as focus on developing relationships with Hungarian pastors and church leaders, and continue researching how to best serve the different churches in Hungary.*

What will Zsofi be doing? *Zsofi will support John, while nurturing and loving baby Wilson. Also, she will seek to use her talent and training in Christian Psychology to counsel in whatever way God will enable her.*

How can we keep in touch with you? *We will continue sending you our newsletter, but you can also sign up for more frequent email updates. We will post messages and pictures on our blog, so check it out from time to time. We would also love to hear from you, so please send us a note, an email, or a package with some sweets for John! :-)*

When are you going to be back? *Our first term is for 3 years. After that, we will return to the U.S. for 3-6 months to reconnect with our supporters and supporting churches and report on all the things that God has done during the first 3 years!*
